Wildhorse Gardens & Market Volunteers Rules

Produce from Wildhorse Gardens will be split as follows:

- 1. Approximately one third will be donated to the Kiwanis Food Pantry and/or to other local organizations, approximately one third will be sold at Wildhorse Market, and approximately one third will be split among volunteers that work in the garden.
- 2. If Wildhorse Market is not operating, harvested produce will be divided between the Kiwanis and/or other local organizations and garden volunteers.
- 3. Produce will be made available to the Kiwanis as early as possible on Saturday mornings so they will have it available to distribute on Saturday mornings.
- 4. Volunteers may take reasonable amounts of produce from the garden for their immediate family use at any time.

Garden Rules:

- 1. The Wildhorse Gardens and Market is a "G" rated environment. No alcoholic beverages, no smoking, and no foul language are allowed.
- Volunteers may bring their own tools to works with in the garden or utilize those available in the storage shed. No pesticides, fertilizers, fresh manure, or chemicals may be applied to the garden without approval from the WGM Presiden.
- 3. Volunteers must be courteous to other volunteers at all times and be willing to explain to interested people what we do at Wildhorse Gardens and Market.
- 4. Any differences of opinion may be brought to the WGM President for resolution.

Wildhorse Market Rules:

- 1. All Food Safety Rules must be followed.
- 2. Hand washing is required.
- 3. Sales will be handled by the Market Manager, Treasurer, and/or Designee.
- 4. Volunteers must be courteous to other volunteers, vendors and customers at all times.

All rules are subject to change.
